Harmony Public Schools would like to inform you of an important change in the after-school childcare program at your student's campus.

Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the campus after-school care program will be administered by the Harmony Education Foundation, rather than by our previous provider Zenith Learning. The fee structure will remain the same.

The [Harmony Education Foundation](#) (HEF) is a tax-exempt, nonprofit organization founded with the sole purpose of improving educational outcomes for Harmony Public Schools students.

Among other efforts, the Harmony Education Foundation provides:

- Significant scholarship awards to HPS alumni;
- Financial support in the form of grants to community-based and philanthropic classroom programs;
- Scholarships to current students with financial needs;
- Micro-grants to Harmony teachers creating innovations and improvements in the classroom;
- Grants to Harmony campuses for specific projects.

Because the HEF is entirely nonprofit, we anticipate that any revenues generated by the HEF after-school program exceeding childcare program costs will be distributed to these HEF Harmony support projects.
